### History

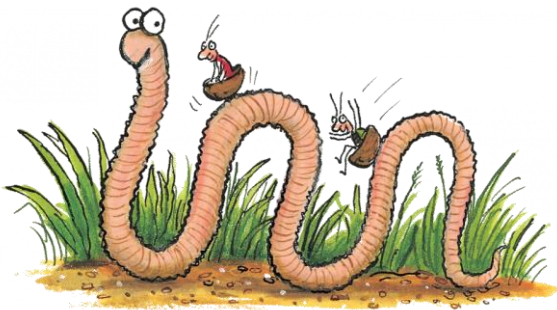
### Science
