Thank you to everyone for helping to making the first full school term so wonderful. The children have all made such amazing progress already in their new learning.


English

In Year 2, this term's writing stimulus is 'The Girl and the Dinosaur' by Hollie Hughes. We will be creating character and setting descriptions and nonfictional reports based on the text, including conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and different sentence types.



<u>PE</u>

The children will take part in PE on a Monday and Friday afternoon. We will continue working with First Steps and Tigers Trust this term.
