

Year 3 Spring Newsletter

Welcome to a new term in Year 3!

History

This half term, we are working as historians and focusing on 'Hull's Heroes'. We will be learning three 'Hull Heroes'; Thomas Ferens, Clive Sullivan and Mary Murdoch. We will research why they are important.

Maths

In maths, the children will be focusing on division. Children will be learning to divide 2 digit by 1 digit numbers and other division strategies. We will then move onto measurement, including area and perimeter.



Reading & Writing

In Year 3, the children will be using 'Iron Man – Ted Hughes' as a stimulus for reading and writing. We will be writing a 5-part narrative, as well as cinquain poetry and a diary entry. Through reading, we will ask questions, compare themes between texts and make predictions as well as read for pleasure.

PSHE, Art & Religion and World Views

Our PSHE focus is 'Dreams and Goals'. Our Art focus is 'Jackson Pollock' and printing skills. Our focus for R&WV is 'Faith Founders'.

Science

Our science topic for this term is Forces and Magnets. Children will investigate; different forces, objects which are magnetic as well as creating their own pulleys.



This half term in PE we will focus on dance skills and hockey. Please make sure children bring their PE kits (including jogging bottoms and trainers) to school on a Monday and take them home on a Friday to be cleaned. For these sessions, hair must be tied back and earrings must either be removed for the session or covered, with their own tape, for health and safety reasons.
