Homework and Home Reading

Just a reminder, children are expected to read 3x per week and have this signed off in their reading record by an adult. Homework and home reading books will be sent home on a Friday and need to be returned the following Wednesday to allow time for them to be checked and changed.

Writing & Reading

In Year 1, the children will be using a variety of books as a stimulus for their writing. We will be learning how to write a sentence and use capital letters and full stops accurately. The children will write simple instructions, labels, descriptions and ask questions.

Maths

In maths, we will be focussing on counting through to 100. We will be using number squares and a variety of mathematical apparatus to support learning.

Science

For science, we are going to focus on the different animals and humans. We are going to learn all about herbivores, omnivores and carnivores and discover the different types of animals.

Foundation Subjects

In history, the children will be finding out about toys from the past and within their living memory. We will also explore how toys were made and used. The children will create a timeline and develop their understanding of the past and present.

PE

This term in PE, our indoor focus is on gymnastics.
