
## Autumn Term I

Welcome back to Broadacre!



# Fire of London

## Maths

In maths, the children are learning facts about numbers to 100 and their place value. They will be using practical equipment to make multiples of ten and learn the place value of numbers in a sequence. Throughout this half term, we will be looking at becoming fluent in adding and subtracting within 20, 50 and 100, using different methods.

## PE

The children will take part in PE on Monday afternoons with Tigers Trust. Please make sure children bring their PE kits to school on a Monday and take them home on a Friday to be cleaned. The children should wear plain black, blue or white clothing.



## <u>Science</u>

Our science topic for this half term is 'Animals including Humans'. Children will learn what humans and animals need to survive and stay healthy. We also will explore life cycles of different animals and why some life cycles can differ to humans'.



We will be working as historians and learning about the Great Fire of London. We will be learning about the cause of the fire, how it was dealt with and the impact of Samuel Pepys.
