Spanish Overview

*Pupils at Broadacre learn Spanish from Year 3 to Year 6.

	Autumn	Spring	Summer
Year 3	Ask and answer "What is your name?" Count and order the numbers 1-10.	Repeat and follow classroom instructions. Develop simple sentences about a favourite animal. Ask and answer "How many..." questions.	Order simple food items in Spanish. Ask and answer simple questions about days of the week.
Year 4	List numbers 11-31, identifying the pattern. Tell someone when it is your birthday.	Label parts of the body, in Spanish. Name and locate shapes, using simple adjectives to describe them.	Discuss family members and pets in a two-way conversation. Answer simple comprehension questions in Spanish.
Year 5	Ask and answer "What time is it?" Ask and answer "Do you like?" about music.	Give opinions, in Spanish, about different sports. Compose simple movement instructions using Spanish.	Hold a conversation stating which musical instruments you can play. Ask and answer questions about preferences.
Year 6	Use the present tense to describe the weather in Spanish. Link weather to typical climates in England and in Spain.	Describe a festival in Spanish, using key learned vocabulary. Give reasons, in Spanish, for liking/disliking a festival.	What are the key elements of culture in Spain and other Spanish-speaking countries?
