## Writing & Reading

This term, the children will continue to use 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' as their main text. The children will use a range of skills to support their comprehension including summarising, retrieval and inference.

## Science

As scientists, the children will be exploring living things and their habitats. They will first focus on the 6 main groups of species and then work on being able to classify plants and living things. The pupils will then work on creating a classification key based on their findings.

## Maths

Throughout this term, the children will continue to master adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators. The children will compare fractions by finding a common denominator. Alongside this, to keep their arithmetic knowledge fresh, the children will be working on a range of skills to support gaining that 30+ mark on the arithmetic paper.

## Foundation Subjects

During the Autumn term, Year 6 will brush up on their Spanish knowledge by recapping the four seasons and expanding their knowledge by learning different types of weather, climates and countries.

In PSHE, we will be celebrating differences between one another and understanding that there are different perceptions of what 'normal' means.

In Religion and Worldviews, the children will be investigating Christianity and the significance of the birth of Jesus.

## PE

This term in PE, our indoor focus is on paired gymnastics and our outdoor topic is tag rugby. The children will have PE on the following days:
