The reading books come with a reading record. We aim to record reading with each child four or more times a week. Short burst sessions are encouraged.

For these sessions, hair must be tied back and earrings must either be removed for the session or covered, with their own tape.

English and Guided Reading

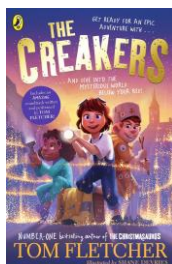
In Year 3, we are using a short, stop-motion stimulus called 'migrants' to inspire our writing. We will be writing for a wide range of purposes such as to entertain and to inform. Writing setting descriptions, story openers and wanted posters.

In guided reading, we are reading 'Creakers' by Tom Fletcher. This text helps form a basis for the different reading domains that the children are learning. This half term, we are looking at retrieval, prediction and inference to name a few.

Wider Curriculum

In History this half term,artworke looking at 'Hull Heroes' where we will be doing an in-depth look into the lives of Clive Sullivan, Mary Murdoch and James Reckitt.

In art, we are looking at the artist Favianna Rodriguez whose work lies in nature. The children will be using their knowledge of the colour wheel to recreate her artwork and use newly taught skills such as printing.
