Parents Meetings

Times Tables RockStar (TTRS) Day

On Wednesday 5th March, we will celebrate Times Tables RockStar Day. TTRS is a programme that allows pupils to practise their recall of times tables facts. Pupils in Key Stage 2 all use this programme regularly. On 5th March, we invite pupils to dress as a rock star.

Throughout the day, there will be competitions between the classes and other activities based around times tables.

Comic Relief

On Friday 14th March, we will help raise money for Comic Relief. Pupils can wear non-uniform on that day.
