English and Guided Reading

Whilst some of our children are working hard on their phonics sounds, decoding and sharing stories, the older children are using an exciting, new vocabulary-rich text "The Lost Thing" by Shaun Tan.

In Writing, the children are using Zog as a stimulus for writing, focusing on transcription and composition skills. In the other side of the base, the children are using Pandora's box as a stimulus and are aiming to write a letter to Mr Wilkinson to persuade him to let us open our mystery box. We are all very excited.

School visits

The whole of the base will be visiting Sewerby Hall in the summer term to take part in a history workshop, visit penguins at the zoo and to explore the gardens.

Blended Learning

Each pupil in the ASC Resource Base receives a bespoke offer to meet their individual needs. Some children will be accessing lessons in the mainstream school – this is really exciting for the pupils. All blended learning opportunities are considered on an individual basis and are built up gradually to support the pupil. In the Summer Term, our children in Year 6 will be working towards their SATS tests and towards their secondary school transitions.

P.E

For the summer term, the children will take part in P.E on a Monday so please can we ensure they have a kit, suitable for outside with the weather getting warmer.

Maths

In Maths, we are working on a range of mathematical concepts and outer maths activities, including length and measurement, fractions and mass and capacity. The children will be using practical, visual and concrete resources to support their maths skills and to help consolidate their learning.

Curriculum

In History this half term, some of the children will be learning about Mary Anning's fossils and Neil Armstrong's achievements, whilst the older children will be delving into the lives of Victorians.

In Art, all of the children will be focussing on sculpture and by the end of the half term will have created their own sculptures in the style of either Peter Diem or Andy Goldsworthy.

We have ordered a selection of new outdoor play equipment to facilitate our new, engaging team-building games, which consists of: parachutes, skipping ropes, a bubble machine, sack races and much more.
