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FSI - Our Learning

In Literacy this half term, we are going to be looking at two main focus stories: The Very Hungry Caterpillar and How to Catch a Rainbow. We will be focussing on healthy foods, sequencing short stories and the language used within the book.

In Maths, we will be recognising numbers 1-5 and linking quantities. We will also be looking at making AB patterns with different resources.

In Phonics, we will be looking at initial sounds of words including our names, syllabic deletion and environmental sounds. The children will have the opportunities to create different sounds using their voices and other resources.

FS2 - Our Learning

This half term in FS2 we will be reading the traditional tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and the non-fiction text, 'Growing Beans'. The children will be writing for a range of purposes including invitations, thank you letters, labelling and writing lists.

In maths, we will be learning about the composition of numbers to 20 and beyond. We will also be looking at adding and subtracting 1.

In phonics, the children will be continuing their Read Write Inc journey and developing their reading fluency.

As part of our wider curriculum, the children will be learning about the life cycle of a bean plant and growing their own. We will also be developing our colour mixing skills.
