



Maths

This half term, the Sky Pathway learners will be engaging in provision related to 'cause & effect'. This will be linked to our theme and using core vocabulary.

The Cobalt Pathway will be learning about odds and evens and measuring distance.

Our KS2 learners will continue to join the main school for their maths learning.

Science

In this unit, the children will be learning about plants. We will explore different parts of a plant, how to plant seeds and how to care for plants. We will also look at caring for our planet and the different ways to do so. As always, our science learning will be 'hands on'.

PE

This term in PE, our focus will be apparatus sequences and partner balancing. Our PE sessions will be on Thursdays so please send your children with PE clothing.

Sky Pathway

For the children on the Sky Pathway, this term's focus will continue to be communication and interaction, more specifically engaging & interacting and making requests. Our provision will be linked to the theme 'In the Jungle'. This theme will run across our story times, sensory and messy play, and resources throughout the term. We will continue to work towards individual communication targets.

Life Skills

This term, we will be practising various life skills to keep ourselves clean and healthy. This includes, brushing teeth, hand washing, dressing and clothing care, keeping ourselves clean, healthy eating and simple snacks. These sessions are designed to support our learners with independent living, looking after ourselves and will be taught using fun and sensory based activities.

English

For our Sky Pathway children, we will be focussing our provision around engaging & interacting and making requests. This will be individualised to work towards their targets as well as linking in with our theme 'In the Jungle'.

This term, the Cobalt Pathway children will continue to develop our vocabulary in writing. Our focus text will be Peter Rabbit, and the children will be writing their own character descriptions and instructions inspired by these stories.

Our KS2 learners will be exploring the story 'The Wish Granter'. They will be writing persuasive texts and looking at first-person perspectives.

Geography

In geography, we are learning about physical and human geography. We will practice sorting physical and human features and will link this to our local area. Our KS2 learners will carry out field work and will take a walk around our local area.

This term in DT, we will be working towards making our very own drawstring bag. We will investigate different examples, design our own, make prototypes and then finally make our finished product.
