



Maths

In maths, the children will be exploring place value within 50. Children will learn to partition numbers into tens and ones, recognising numerical patterns, and count confidently up to 50. They also investigate measurement, comparing and exploring length, height, mass, and volume.

Science

This term, children will be exploring the wonders of the natural world. Children will learn how to plant seeds, care for them as they grow, and observe the changes that happen over time. They will be introduced to the different parts of a flowering plant. Children will be learning different ways to care for the planet and to protect living things in their environment.

Design and Technology

This term in Design & Technology, Year I will design and create their very own fabric puppets. Children will develop their sewing skills by learning how to use a running stitch to join pieces of material together. They will also explore different puppets and participate in a puppet workshop as well as watch a puppet show.

Celebrations

Children will take part in a visiting puppet workshop to launch their new DT topic. They will also go on a walk in the local area for a geography fieldwork lesson, with more details to follow.

English

This term, children will continue writing simple sentences using adjectives and verbs. Children will also be practising joining two sentences together by using 'and'. Children will be introduced to who, what, where sentences based on our focus texts, Peter Rabbit and Sam and the Sunflower, where we will be writing character descriptions.

Geography

In geography, children will be learning about the human and physical features of the world, starting with our local area. The children will take part in fieldwork around the school and nearby neighbourhood. We will also look closely at photographs of a nearby seaside town to explore its human and physical features.

PE

Year I will have two PE lessons each week. On Monday, children will be outdoors, developing passing and shooting skills through football and hockey games. On Friday, they will have an indoor lesson focussing on dance and movement. Please ensure all children have their PE kit in school on these days.
