



Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on different types of measure that include; length, height, mass, capacity and temperature.

Science

Our science topic for this half term is 'animals and their habitats'. The children will be learning about what animals need to survive and how they adapt to live in different environments.

PE

Year 2 are working with Tigers Trust this half term. They will be working on their athletic skills, beginning with sending and receiving balls. In our outdoor lesson, we are also working on playing games to develop strength and independence within play.

Writing

In Year 2, the children are using 'Rainbow Bear' for their writing stimulus this half term. We will be exploring the story using a variety of conjunctions, punctuation and sentence types. The children will also be finding out about polar bears and brown bears, creating information texts and writing a recount of our visit to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park.

Geography

We will be learning about where England is in relation to the rest of the world. We will be looking at and creating our own maps of the local area to develop the children's awareness of where they live and the local environment.

D&T

This half term, the children will be exploring sewing techniques and making their own bag. They will evaluate different types of bags and design their own based on what they have learned.

Computing

Year 2 will be learning about Algorithms and the importance of order and clarity when giving instructions. The children will be creating and following algorithms on how to make a simple lego structure or drawing for example.
