### Maths

This half term, we will be focusing on measurement including length and perimeter, as well as converting cm, m and mm. Towards the end of the term, we will be taking a closer look at fractions and mass and capacity, too.

### Reading and Homework

Homework is set every Friday, and this should be returned the following Tuesday. Reading books will also be sent out on a Friday and collected in on Wednesday. The reading books come with a reading record. If and when you read with your child (even if it is a book from home) you can pop a note in their reading records. This helps us keep track.

### PE Kit

This half term, the children will be focusing on orienteering and dance. Please make sure children bring their PE kits (including trainers) to school on a **Monday** and **take them home on a Friday** to be cleaned. For these sessions, hair must be tied back and earrings must either be removed for the session or covered, with their own tape.

### Spring performance

Towards the end of the term, Year 3 will be putting on a spring performance for parents. This will take place on the 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> March. Further information to follow closer to the date.

### English and Guided Reading

In Year 3, we are using a performance poem by Michael Rosen, called the Bakerloo Flea, to act as our vehicle of inspiration for our writing this half term. The children will be creating a range of writing inspired by this prompt.

In guided reading, we are continuing reading 'Creakers' by Tom Fletcher. This text helps form a basis for the different reading domains that the children are learning. This half term, we are looking at retrieval, prediction and inference to name a few.

### Wider Curriculum

In Geography this half term, we will be learning a little more about the United Kingdom its counties and learning about the local area, too.

This half term, in art, we are focussing on printing – inspired by the work of *Favianna Rodriguez*. We are so excited to produce our own prints.
