Reading and Writing

We will be using Michael Morpurgo's 'Kensuke's Kingdom' again as a focus for our reading as well as a range of other texts to develop our reading further. We will be developing our retrieval, vocabulary and inference skills in reading. As well as this, we will be writing in a range of different styles in our writing lessons.

Homework and Home Reading

Foundation Subjects

Our PSHE lessons will continue to give pupils opportunities to discuss a range of scenarios that are topical for Year 6.

Maths

Our focus for Maths this half term is shape, statistics and measure. We will be exploring these areas of wider maths as well as continuing our weekly practice of arithmetic skills that the children need to be secure on for their SATs tests.
