PARENT EVENTS

As you will know, pupils in Years 1, 4 and 6 will take part in statutory testing in the Summer Term.

The dates for the testing are:

Year 6- Monday 11th May; Tuesday 12th May; Wednesday 13th May; Thursday 14th May.

Year 4- Monday 1st June to Friday 12th June

Year 1- Monday 8th June to Friday 12th June

It is essential that pupils are in school for the testing periods.

On Friday 20th March, we held our first "Celebration Day". We invited pupils to show off their trophies, medals, certificates, awards and badges. We were blown away by the talent and commitment of our pupils, as well as the range of activities in which our pupils participate.

After the day's success, we will be holding another Celebration Day in the Summer Term.

ATTENDANCE

After the break, our new attendance competition begins. In the Summer Term (13 weeks) every child who achieves 97% attendance will receive a prize and a ticket for a prize draw. The prizes are bigger than ever with a brand new bike, brand new scooter and Smyths Toy Superstore Giftcard (worth £100) available. To achieve 97% attendance pupils can miss no more than 1.5 days in the Summer Term.

We are also starting to look at attendance in a slightly different way. We are looking at how many days in a row pupils attend school without an absence. We will be sharing this information with pupils and parents and celebrating pupils who break their best ever "streak".

Currently, there are 5 pupils with streaks of over 500 days; 23 pupils with streaks of over 300 days; 104 pupils with streaks of over 100 days and 212 pupils with streaks of over 50 days.

CELEBRATION

This term, our pupils have been out on a wider range of trips and visits than ever before.

A group of pupils visited Hull Truck Theatre and performed on the stage. This was a unique opportunity and staff and spectators spoke very highly of the pupils' behaviour, attitudes and skill.
